**RE**: Revised DDA Intake and Eligibility Determination Policy and Procedure

Effective May 8, 2023, DDS releases its revised DDA Intake and Eligibility Determination Policy (2023-DDA-POL001) and Procedure (2023-DDA-PR001). The Policy and Procedure are applicable to all DDS employees responsible for activities associated with the receipt and processing of applications for DDA services and supports and to all employees responsible for activities necessary to determine an applicant's eligibility to receive DDA services and supports.

These revisions implement, and align the agency's policy with, the "Developmental Disability Eligibility Reform Amendment Act of 2022," which expanded eligibility for DDA services to people with developmental, but not intellectual, disabilities. The revised policy documents also advance DDA's policy of ensuring that all people who apply for services are processed through the Intake and Eligibility Determination Units in a timely, fair, and professional manner.

In pertinent part, the revised Policy clarifies that DDA's Eligibility Determination Unit ("EDU") has 90 days from the receipt of a "signed and dated" application for services to make most eligibility determinations. This provision replaces the past Policy's requirement that eligibility determinations be made within 90 days of the receipt of a "completed" application. Several timelines governing the processing of applications by EDU personnel have changed in the Procedure as well, all of which have the effect of holding our team to the agency's standard of excellent customer service.
