VOTER ACCESS TEAM

The D.C. Board of Elections (BOE) is currently seeking volunteers to join our Voter Access Team. Volunteers will work with the ADA Coordinator and other election officials to ensure that all district residents have equal access to our polling sites and voting process, on Election Day.

More specifically, volunteers will be assigned 4-5 polling sites and tasked with creating accessible routes, removing physical barriers that would prevent voters with disabilities/senior citizens from entering the site, unlocking heavy doors, creating temporary accessible parking/drop-off spaces etc. Volunteers will also monitor their assigned polling sites throughout the day to ensure that they remain operationally accessible. Volunteers must have access to reliable transportation and be available on Election Day (June 19th, 2018) from 6:00am to 8:00pm. **Volunteers will receive a \$250 stipend.**

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Prior experience working with senior citizens and/or people with disabilities preferred
- Experience working during an election is preferred
- Must attend a mandatory training class on Wednesday, June 13, 2018, 5:00pm - 9:00pm
OR Saturday, June 16, 2018 10:00am - 2:00pm
- Volunteer on Election Day Tuesday, June 19, 2018 from 6:00am to 8:00pm
- Volunteers DO NOT have to be DC residents
