Job Corps is a no-cost education and vocational training program administered by the U.S. Department of Labor that helps young people ages 16 through 24 improve the quality of their lives through vocational and academic training. The upper-age limit shall be waived for individuals with disclosed disabilities who meet all other eligibility requirements. (The minimum age requirement of 16 remains the same regardless of disability status.)

Students interested in enrolling in a listed college or community college degree or certificate program should be encouraged to enter through the <u>disability support offices</u> and access available support and resources to help ensure successful program completion. Note: Dietary aides typically work at hospitals or nursing homes and assisted living facilities and must pass a thorough background check. Preferred or required qualifications include culinary training or food service experience and a safe food-handling license. Responsibilities include assisting residents or patients with menu selections, preparing and serving food and beverages, and cleaning trays, dishes and utensils, although cleaning and dishwashing duties may be performed by kitchen stewards.

Dietary aides must be detail oriented and possess excellent customer service skills. The ability to use a computer may be required to assist residents or patients with ordering menu items. Some dietary aides are nursing assistants, making applicants with culinary training/experience and a CNA license highly marketable.
