### RSA Statuses and Timelines

#### Successful Closure for DDA-RSA Process

1. **Status 00** – Person has submitted a referral and is interested in receiving services.
2. **Status 02** – Person has signed an application for VR and completed the intake process to receive VR services.
  - a. VR counselor has **60 days** to determine eligibility. Client has to submit all required documentation for eligibility.
  - b. When a person has already been determined eligible for DDS services, VR counselor has **one week** to determine eligibility for RSA services
3. **Status 10** – Person who has submitted all documentation will proceed through eligibility. At this status, a client would be determined eligible for services.
  - a. VR counselor has **90 days** to meet with the client, complete a comprehensive needs assessment based on existing evaluations, and then develop an IPE.
4. **Status 12** – Person has worked with their counselor to complete an IPE and sign is so services can be rendered for the person.
5. **Status 18** – Person is actively receiving services for education, training, or any other paid services. If a person is still in secondary school, they are placed here until they graduate.
6. **Status 20** – Person is deemed ready to go to work.
7. **Status 22** – Person has a job and is actively working at that job in a competitive, integrated work environment.
  - a. Person must demonstrate stabilization for **at least 90 days** at their job.
8. **Status 26** – After a person is deemed stable on their job for at least 90 days, then the person is able to be successfully closed.
