DDS AND DCHR PARTNER TO INCREASE EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

Washington, DC— On Wednesday, December 13, the DC Department on Disability Services (DDS) and the DC Department on Human Resources (DCHR) will partner to host an Employment Information Session for people with disabilities. More than 60 people are expected to attend the event, which will take place at 10 am at DDS, 250 E Street, SW. DCHR Disability Employment Specialist Miriam Aybar-Morales will instruct participants in using the District’s newly reconfigured applicant tracking system and review the District’s hiring process. The Employment Information Session is for employment specialists, vocational rehabilitation counselors, and people with disabilities currently supported by DDS. It reflects Mayor Bowser’s ongoing commitment to establish the District as a model employer of people with disabilities.
